On February 23, 2023, Northwest School of Medicine Peshawar held its first ever convocation ceremony awarding degrees to 94 male and female graduates of its pioneer MBBS batch of session 2016-2021.

Additionally, Dr. Asadullah Khan was awarded the gold medal for outstanding contribution towards extracurricular and informal academic activities.

TURKISH AMBASSADOR VISIT


Turkish Ambassador Dr. Mehmet Paçacı visits Northwest School of Medicine on 16 June 2023.




Certificate in Health Research

Disaster Drill By Rescue 1122

A mock major disaster drill was arranged by the Department of Occupational Health, Safety and Environment (OHS&E) in collaboration with Rescue 1122 at the Northwest School of Medicine (NWSM) on 21 June 2023. A Large number of Students, Faculty and Non-Faculty staff, and Demonstrators participated in the session. Lab The Rescue 1122 representatives Mr. Inayat Ur Rehman, medical safety instructor and Mr. Khalil Ur Rehman, fire and safety instructor, trained the participants on first aid provision, emergency evacuation and fire safety. The mock drill also helped identify the limitations of the current emergency preparedness plan. Realistic emergency preparedness drills and exercises can help ensure a more effective response when disaster strikes. Studying lessons learned from other emergencies and practicing simulations is the best alternative to real-world experience because the ability to equivocally learn in a replicated environment strengthens readiness to respond during a disaster.
